THURSDAY, AUG. 18—SAN FRANCISCO 1906 Fire and Earthquake Damage

The inferno destroyed some 28,000 buildings, and the total property value loss was estimated at \$350 million. Some 700 people originally were thought to have died in the disaster, but the death toll is now believed to have exceeded 3,000. Our tour guide, Craig Smith will take us to historic sites of buildings that survived. We'll enjoy lunch on Pier 39 at Swiss Louis Italian & Seafood Restaurant.

THURSDAY, OCT. 20—FELTON TRAIN Bear Mountain

We will travel over trestles, through towering redwood groves and up a winding narrow-gauge grade to the summit of Bear Mountain as conductors narrate the history of Roaring Camp, the railroad, and the forest. Roaring Camp's steam engines date from 1890 and are among the oldest and most authentically preserved narrow-gauge steam engines providing regularly scheduled passenger service in America. Enjoy the old-fashioned fun of the 1880s including a chuckwagon BBQ!
